

**ORDINANCE NO. 16-103
CITY OF COURTLAND, NICOLLET COUNTY, MINNESOTA**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER III OF THE CITY CODE OF THE CITY OF COURTLAND TO OPT-OUT OF THE REQUIREMENTS OF MINNESOTA STATUTES, SECTION §462.3593

WHEREAS, on May 12, 2016, Governor Dayton signed into law the creation and regulation of temporary family health care dwellings, codified at Minnesota Statute §462.3593, which permit and regulate temporary family health care dwellings; and

WHEREAS, subdivision 9 of Minnesota Statute §462.3593 allows municipalities to “opt out” of those regulations.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COURTLAND:


SECTION I. That Chapter III is hereby amended to add the following:

303.26. Opt-out of the requirements of Minnesota Statute §462.3593.

Pursuant to authority granted by Minnesota Statutes, Section 462.3593, subdivision 9, the City of Courtland, Minnesota hereby opts-out of the requirements of Minnesota Statute §462.3593, which defines and regulates Temporary Family Health Care Dwellings. The requirements of Minnesota Statute §462.3593 shall not apply within the City’s corporate limits.


SECTION II. That this ordinance shall take effect and shall be in force 30 days from and after its adoption, approval, and publication.
