


ORDINANCE 21-101
APPROVING THE AMENDMENT OF THE PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY ORDINANCE

The City of Courtland on the seventh day of January 2021 approves the proposed amendment to the Public Right-Of-Way Ordinance as stated:

Amendment to 401.06 Residential Access.

- **401.06 Residential Access. (Page 71)**
 - Residential properties shall be permitted one access per parcel, except where said parcel has frontage on both a municipal street and municipal street or alley, in which case access will be permitted to both rights-of-way.
 - If the property is a corner lot, a second access will be permitted considered that the property line of said parcel is a minimum of 100 ft in length.
 - If the frontage property line is greater than 150 feet, a second access will be permitted on the same frontage as the original access.
 - Permitted accesses shall be situated to minimize creation of traffic or safety hazards.
